APPLICATION FOR THE STRAITS TIMES SCHOOL POCKET MONEY FUND (STSPMF) IN 2019

1. The Straits Times School Pocket Money Fund (STSPMF) is a financial assistant scheme which provides pocket money to school-going children from low-income families. The successful applicant can use the money for school-related expenses such as recess meals or their bus fares.
2. The application for STSPMF is now opened to our Primary 1 to Primary 5 students who will be continuing their studies in our school next year.
3. Successful applicants, including MOE FAS students, will receive the monthly school pocket money of \$60 through our school.
4. Please note that we can only accept applications from our students who meet the following criteria:
 - a.) Student is a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Singapore Permanent Resident (SPR); and
 - b.) Family is living in a 4-room HDB Flat or smaller; and
 - c.) Family has a gross per capita income (PCI) of \$625/month or less; and
 - d.) Is not concurrently receiving school pocket money fund from disbursing agencies; and
 - e.) Is not concurrently receiving other similar monthly school pocket money schemes (*Note that applicant under the MOE Financial Assistance Scheme are eligible*); and
 - f.) Has not been a STSPMF beneficiary for more than 24 months for the whole schooling years of primary education.
5. If your child is eligible to apply, please collect the application form from the General Office (GO) and return the completed form with the relevant documents to the GO by **Wednesday, 15 August 2018.**
